Cora Stravei Vermouth '70s

First produced in the 1970s in Costigliole d'Asti, Italy, Stravei Cora Vermouth is a bitter red vermouth aromatised with herbs and spices. It is a popular label among spirit collectors and cocktail enthusiasts.

Super Punch Jannamico '60s

Produced by the Jannamico family since the late 1800s in Abruzzo, Italy, Super Punch is a liqueur of ancient Abruzzese tradition and today, it continues to entice with its citrus notes and rum base.

Amaro Mandorla '70s

By blending herbs, citrus and botanicals, and distilled in different steps, Amaro Mandorla features an elegance of aromas and taste that is further enhanced as a result of the aging process.

Ferro-China Bisleri '70s

A world-famous bitter aperitif liqueur with a Ferric Citrate base, Ferro-China Bisleri can be drunk at any time of the day, preferably before meals, dry or diluted with plain or mineral water.
